

# OCHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes

## September 8, 2009

The September meeting was called to order by President Susan Wells at 6:30 pm. There were seven officers and two parents present.

Reports:

Secretary (Dana Pass):

- Copies of the August minutes were distributed.

Treasurer (Shannon Harrell):

- There are currently \$1585.34 in checks still out. The current balance in the account is \$24,360.
- The annual audit is not yet complete due, but will be scheduled shortly.

Fundraisers:

5K Monster Dash

- To encourage families to seek sponsorships, it was proposed that 10% of sponsorships be allocated to the student's account. The boosters approved this recommendation.
- The race organizer recommended that all workers wear the race T-shirt.
- Volunteers are needed to help with the clean-up. Shannon will oversee this.
- The 5K Committee will meet at Jittery Joe's on 9/28 at 6:15pm.

Cowlenders

- Deb Kight is handling the calendar sales this year
- Chick-fil-a is asking the boosters to sign a contract. They will sell for \$7 apiece and the student will earn \$3 for their account.
- They come 50 to a box so we will start with 200 and get more as needed.
- The sales period will be September 10<sup>th</sup> – November 2<sup>nd</sup>
- If we sell them at the games, that would be for the general fund.

Outback Dinner

- There is a conflict with the planned date (4/23) for the dinner. The spring musical is scheduled that weekend, which will typically involves Mr. Provost and several band students. March 19<sup>th</sup> will be explored as an alternate date.

President (Susan Wells):

- The Mother's Huddle has complained that the boosters prevented them from selling concessions at the scrimmage game and is seeking compensation. After discussion, it was decided that former band members would be contacted for information on previous years.
- The competitions will be at North Paulding HS and Hiram HS on October 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>
