Reports:

- We currently have \$17,294.17 in the bank. There are 3 checks that have not cleared totaling approximately \$2045. There are three checks (\$398) that have been returned by the bank. Coke still owes us \$888.63. At this point we are close to, or a little ahead of where we were a year ago.

Member at Large/Auxiliary (Brooke McWhorter):

- Susan and I met with Outback. We are set to have steak, chicken, mashed potatoes, salad, bread and tea. They will have a trailer outside the civic center to cook the food. We are planning to sell the tickets for \$15.00. The dinner will be 4/23, 5:30-7:30.

President (Susan Wells):

- Mr. Provost wanted us to know that there would not be an eighth grade recruiting this month. We are not sure if there will be one at another time.
- An email to Mr. Provost to confirm that the Civic Center has been reserved for both the dinner and the band awards.
- We will need to check the concession stand and remove any leftover drinks and chips.
- Mr. Provost has asked if the boosters would be willing to provide funds for rising ninth graders to attend UGA's Step-Off camp again this year. There was consensus that the boosters would do so.
