

OCHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes
September 14, 2010

The September meeting was called to order by President Deb Kight at 6:03 pm. Charles Adams, Tina Carter, Terry Centner, Rocco Del Sesto, Guy Johnson, Mary Moore, Karen Pavao, and Brooke McWhorter were present.

The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Treasurer Rocco Del Sesto reported on good sales at the last home game concession stand and the finances for the upcoming 5K race. He plans to get together with Mark Provost to finalize figures for an annual budget to be presented at the October meeting.

First Vice President Brooke McWhorter reported that 8th Grade night will be on October 8th starting with a party with balloons and snacks in the covered pavilion.

Second Vice President Tina Carter reported that the Bandathon had been successful. For next year, smaller amounts of food were recommended, drinks in smaller cans or cups, and no sticky name tags that fall and stick to the floor. Tina and Brooke are also formulating plans for the dinner in April with a selected date of Thursday, April 28th.

Secretary Terry Centner reported that the directory was out. The topic of updating the web was also discussed as parents and students need access to current information.

Students' Accounts volunteer Karen Pavao reported that an update of accounts was given to Mark Provost this week. It was also mentioned that if parent Mardi Gras shirts are to be ordered, it would be best to proceed immediately during marching band season.

Volunteer Coordinator Guy Johnson announced the concession stand was going well. Three items were noted needing assistance: (1) a driver for the instrument trailer to away games and competitions, (2) sales for sponsorships for the 5K race, and (3) sales of raffle tickets. For the 5K race, it has been decided that middle and high school band students can preregister before the date of the race at a discounted price of \$12.00. Other high school students will be able to preregister on October 12-15th for \$12.00.

Beth Haas has commenced with the sales of car wash tickets. Beth Haas and Tina Carter will direct the sales of Cowlanders starting October 1st. The next meeting is scheduled for October 5th at 6:00 in the band room. The meeting was concluded at 7:22 p.m.
