

OCHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes
January 25, 2011

The January meeting was called to order by President Deb Kight at 6:00 pm. Charles Adams, Tina Carter, Terry Centner, Rocco Del Sesto, Guy Johnson, Brooke McWhorter, and Mark Provost were present.

Secretary Terry Centner reviewed the minutes from the November meeting.

Deb Kight reported on the status of left-over beverages from the concession stand; nearly all have been sold to other school groups. She has also completed paperwork for the refund from Coca Cola. Deb next reported on communications with Jeff Rorabaugh on securing a new host for the Booster web pages. The Board also received an email from webmaster Rebecca Ballard with some thoughts on this topic. The Board decided that Deb should proceed to get a prospectus delineating what would be offered with prices. It was also noted that the Boosters will need permission from OCHS to link the Booster web page to the school.

Treasurer Rocco Del Sesto reported that the Booster account has approximately \$18,500.

Second vice-president Tina Carter reported on the spring Outback dinner scheduled for March 17, 2011 at the Civic Center, with a 6:00 starting time. Tickets will be \$15.00, the theme will be Irish (St. Patrick's Day), and band members will be encouraged to sell tickets to raise funds. Tina will look into advertizing ideas.

It was noted that the next payment for the spring band trip of \$75.00 is due Feb. 1st. Students are able to look at the bulletin board to see how much is in their student accounts to use for their payment.

Mark Provost announced the dates of the 2011 summer band camps. Percussion camp is July 18-20, rookie camp is July 21-22, and full camp is July 26-29. A good number of 8th graders are expected to join the marching band next fall and may necessitate the purchase of additional uniforms. Mark also requested that the Board consider options for a band tower for marching band practices. The scissor lift used by the football team is no longer available. On most days, the top of the bleachers does not work because the sun is in the students' eyes.

The next Board meeting is scheduled for February 8th at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was adjourned at 6:49.
