

OCHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes  
March 8, 2011

The March meeting was called to order by President Deb Kight at 6:02 p.m. Charles Adams, Tina Carter, Terry Centner, Beth Haas, Guy Johnson, Karen Pavao, Rocco Del Sesto, Brooke McWhorter and Mark Provost were present.

Secretary Terry Centner reviewed the minutes from the February meeting.

President Deb Kight reported she received the refund from Coca Cola. Deb read correspondence from Rebecca Ballard on establishing a new website. After some discussion, the Board agreed to work with Jeff Rorabaugh on securing a new host for the Booster web pages, at a cost of \$1,000 plus a monthly maintenance fee of \$35.

Treasurer Rocco Del Sesto reported that the final concession profit for 2010 was \$11,760. He also presented detailed information on the budget for this past year to help guide next year's budget.

Second vice-president Tina Carter reported on the spring Outback dinner, 6:00-8 p.m., March 17, 2011 at the Civic Center. She expects about 190 tickets to be sold.

Student Accounts Coordinator Karen Pavao noted that there were a few outstanding band dues and trip payments. Mark is working with the students to get the money owed.

LGPE (Large Group Performance Evaluation) is Saturday, March 12 with a call time of 1:30. Our performance is set for 3:40 at Jefferson High School in Jefferson. We should return to OCHS around 6 to 6:30 p.m. The Spring trip is April 3-6.

Membership at Large (Instrumental) Coordinator Charles Adams reported he is planning for summer band camp and will be looking for volunteers at the Outback dinner.

The Spring Banquet is set for May 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at the Civic Center. Given the time, it was decided to have families bring food for a meal, and Brooke McWhorter will help coordinate this event.

A discussion followed on a slate of officers and key positions for next year's Board and Booster activities. Several names of persons to contact at the Outback dinner were noted.

The next Board meeting is scheduled for April 12th at 6:00 p.m., and the meeting was adjourned at 7:06 p.m.
