

OCHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes
October 11, 2011

Second Vice President Karen Andrews and Guy Johnson reported on plans for the 5K Race on October 29th. More volunteers are needed, as well as tables, water, and fruit. The committee will also look into having band members sell race tickets at lunch.

Rebecca Ballard responded that the directory is on the web with password protection. Board agreed Mark Provost should share the password with students. She will put up more pictures as soon as she receives them. She also reported that the parent shirts have been distributed.

Outback Steakhouse declined to do the Spring banquet, and the proposal by On the Border was felt to be too high. Deb Kight and Karen Andrews will continue to look into catering alternatives. Another thought was to have the banquet on a Thursday night.

It was also noted that we do not have a videographer.
